Robles was the recipient of the “Jimmy V Perseverance Award” at the ESPN ESPYs and he has also received the NFL “Hispanic Heritage Leadership Award”. Robles is a Nike athlete, the first signed to an agreement after having retired from active participation in a sport. He was inducted to the National Wrestling Hall of Fame in 2012 and is the author of *Unstoppable: From Underdog to Undefeated: How I Became a Champion*. In 2013, President Obama appointed Robles as a member of the President’s Council on Fitness, Sports, and Nutrition.
